



I work with an amazing team of people to reduce violence and improve people's lives in the townships (www.vpuu.org.za), work that requires internal energizing from finding sources of hope, insight, creativity and strength. Starting Thursday, 23 January 2020, the course will meet Thursdays from 6:30-8:30pm at Erin Hall, Rondebosch for 12 consecutive weeks, ending just before Easter. A 3-4 session trial is an option, without committing to all 12 weeks.
